Homily for September 25, 2011

26th Sunday in Ordinary Time



Ezekiel 18:25-28, Philippians 2:2-11, Mt. 21:28-32

Dear People of St. Thomas More,

Today we have another parable about the vineyard. With this being the second vineyard parable, one might wonder--did Jesus have fond memories of playing in a vineyard as a boy? Did he work in one as a teenager? He probably used vineyard because ancient Israel was called the vineyard of God—Vineyards produce grapes—and grapes produce wine—wine is a symbol of the joy of eternity.—Hence Jesus liking the vineyard.

In today's vineyard parable, one son said yes to his father but didn't go out to work in the vineyard—and one said no to his father but went. To do or not to do--to paraphrase Hamlet. Such a simple, stark situation Jesus confronts us with. Either we work in the vineyard for God or not.

One thought I'd like to leave you with—all dogs have tails. I have never seen a naturally tailless dog, have you? The point—every action has consequences: for every action there is an equal or opposite reaction, I believe the physicists say. Actions, like dogs, have things that follow them. If you play with matches, one of the consequences is that something might be set on fire.

All consequences fall into one of two categories: good or bad— moral or immoral. It's an either/or situation—either you work in the vineyard by loving God—loving the good/moral, or not. Either you love, have concern, care for your neighbor, or you don't. Either you have concern for yourself—by not doing self-destructive things—or you don't.

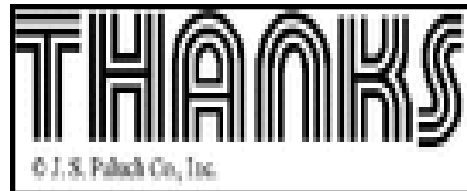
Jesus gives only two commandments—"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." Luke 10:27 Every action says something about what we believe—how aware of God we are. Every action tells those around us what we really think of God.

Today, this week, think of the man who had two sons and told them to go out and work in the vineyard. What would your response be?


